Focal point cased from Rochelle Blok

Measurements

Basic White Thick Cardstock 14.8cm x 21cm Scored at 10.5cm and 5.25cm

Country Woods DSP (2) 4.8cm x 14.4cm

Country Woods DSP Co-ordinating pattern 6.8cm x 11.1cm

Basic White Cardstock 7.2cm x 11.5cm, 7cm x 7cm (Die-cut circle) 2 x 1 3/4" circles

Gray Granite & Mossy Meadow for die cut leaves

Inner 8.5cm x 14.4cm

Misty Moonlight Cardstock 1.5cm x 9.5cm

Petal Pink 2cm x 10cm









Instructions

1. Fold and burnish the card base. Attach the 2 DSP panels to the front. Punch 2 x 1 ¼" circles from Basic White card stock. Fold each one in half and burnish. Adhere one side to the card front with the fold on the edge of the DSP either side of the centre score line and aiming for the middle top to bottom.
2. Emboss the Basic White 7.2cm x 11.5cm piece using the Eyelet 3D embossing folder. Tear the 6.8cm x 11.1cm piece of co-ordinating DSP down the right-hand side, distress further using a bone folder or the edge of a ruler, curl 1 corner. Adhere to the embossed white layer using liquid glue. Put some liquid glue on each of the other sides of the 2 circles and place the focal layer on top centring with the card base.
3. Die-cut the Spotlight on Nature circle and the 2 sets of leaves using the Country Flowers Dies. Cut a length of Linen Thread approx. 30cm long.
4. Stamp the flowers using Memento Black ink and colour with the blends. I start with the light colour of the combo and then add some dark and blend the join line with the light colour. Then to lighten the tips and edges I use the colour lifter. Die cut the flowers using the Country Flowers die.
5. On the die cut circle place some tape or glue dots in the centre and lay the linen thread across to form 2 loops that will stick out beyond the die cuts.
6. Add liquid glue or glue dots to the die cut leaves and adhere to the edge of the circle top and bottom layering the Mossy Meadow over top of the Gray Granite.
7. Add adhesive to the 2 sets of coloured flowers and place them over the leaves. They may overlap a little in the centre.
8. On the Petal Pink piece white emboss the sentiment of your choice and heat to set. Cut the ends into the flag shape and adhere using dimensionals placed on the circle either side of the flowers.
9. Place the Misty Moonlight stopper on the inside of the card base using dimensionals on the right-hand side.
10. Stamp the flower stamp on the inner using a colour or Memento Black and attach inside the card.
11. Add the iridescent pearls as shown.
